





Pronounced jooh-gun, meaning Country in Bundjalung language. Jagun celebrates the land, sky, waters, flora and fauna that together form Country. There is no part of the natural world that is not interconnected with First Nations culture or kin. Exploring her own identity, Holly Sanders invites you on a journey to sing, dance and colour as you discover that Country is more than just a place. Jagun is the third title in the bestselling First Nations Colouring series. It follows on from Mulganai and Nardurna. All of these books are ally friendly and are made to be enjoyed by everyone.






NARDURNA

Start your exploration of Country with Nardurna. Through art and design, Ryhia Dank offers forty-five artworks that share some of her experiences of growing with family and learning her community. Discover the places and the kin that shaped her childhood and the stories that inspire her contemporary art and design work.

Ryhia Dank is a Gudanji/Wakaja woman who grew up in a remote community in the Northern Territory. Now based on Gubbi Gubbi Country, Ryhia's paintings are her storywork. Gudanji/Wakaja people tell stories through pattern and design - Ryhia calls her storying Nardurna

Let Emma Hollingsworth, aka Mulganai, take you on a journey through Country. For Indigenous peoples and allies alike, Emma invites you to discover the places she grew up – Second Beach, Cardwell, Lockhart, Budgebulla – the stories that she was told by her ancestors, and the animals, people and plants that bring her world to life.

Featuring 45 artworks to colour paired with stories and descriptions in Emma's own words, Mulganai is the celebration of a contemporary First Nations artist and her community.
